

Global Resilience Plan (2021-2026)

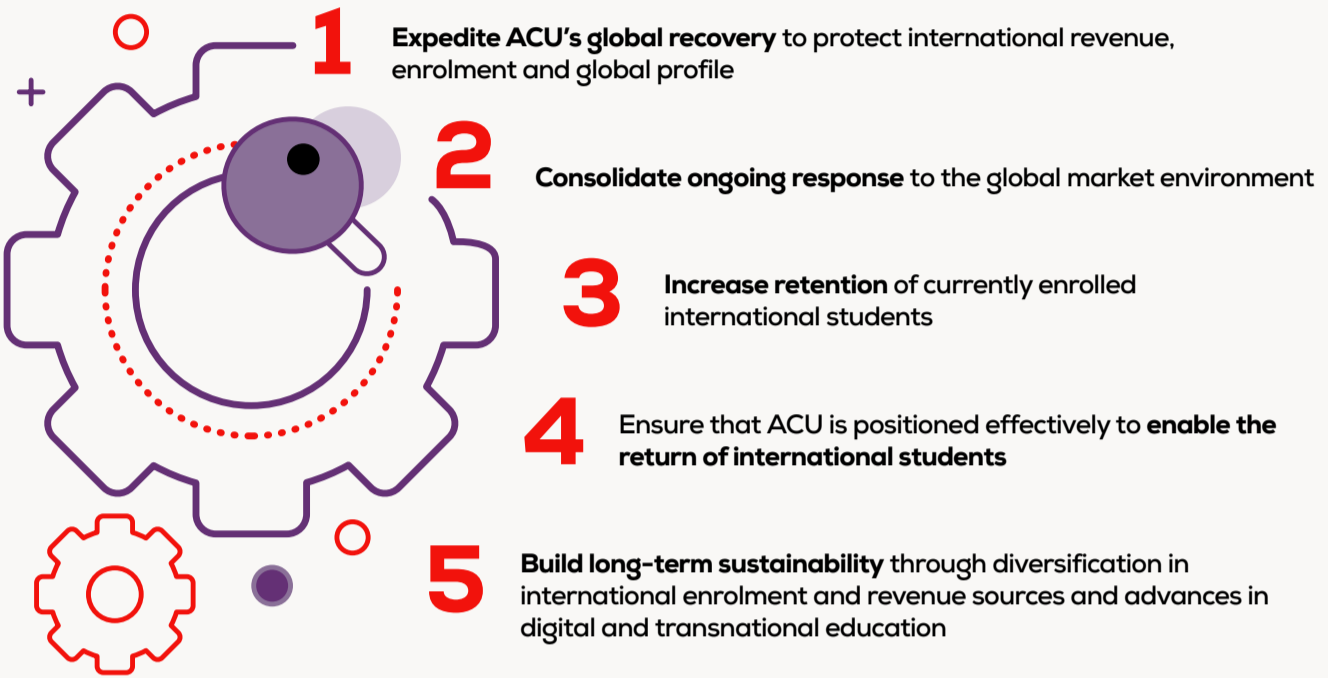

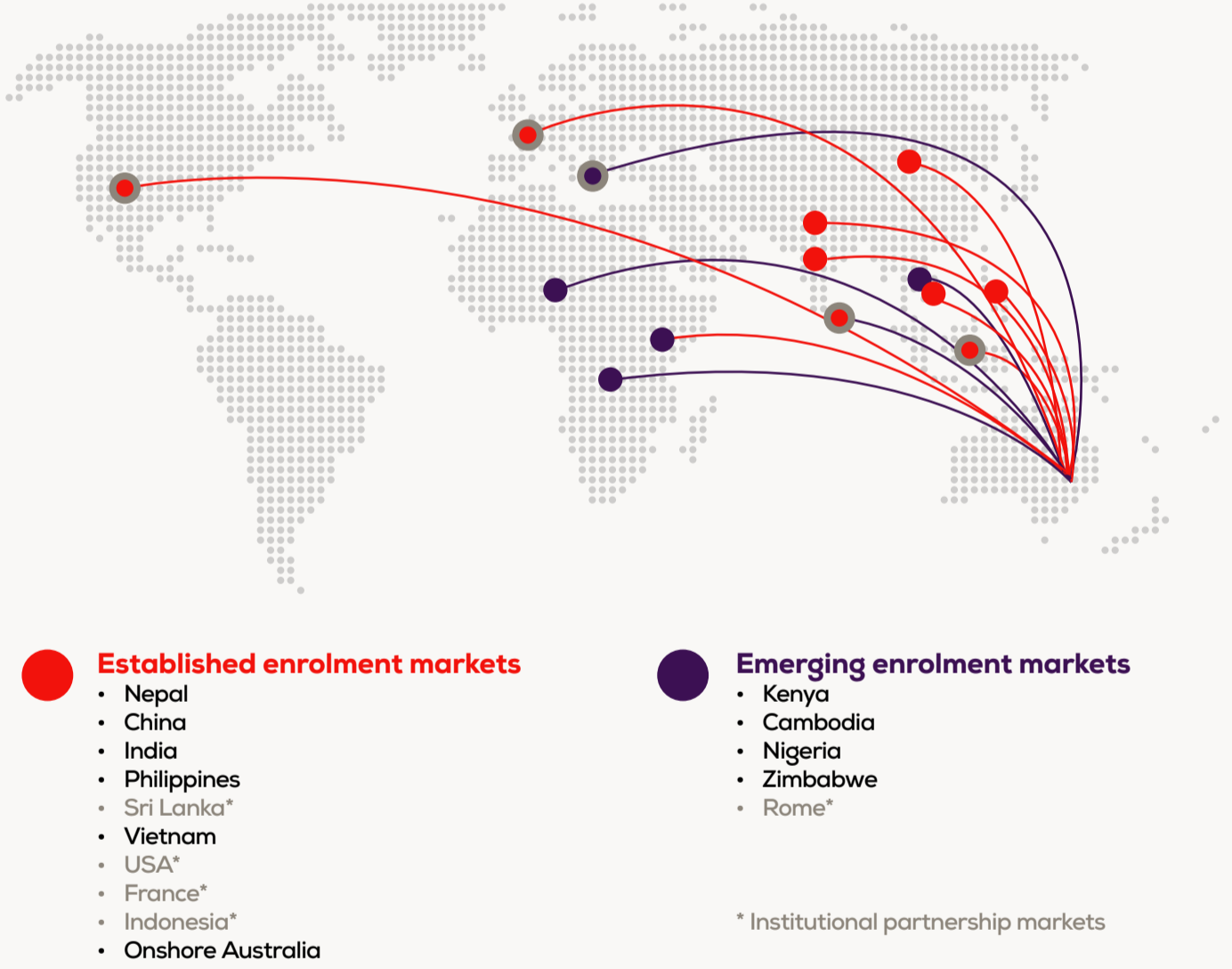

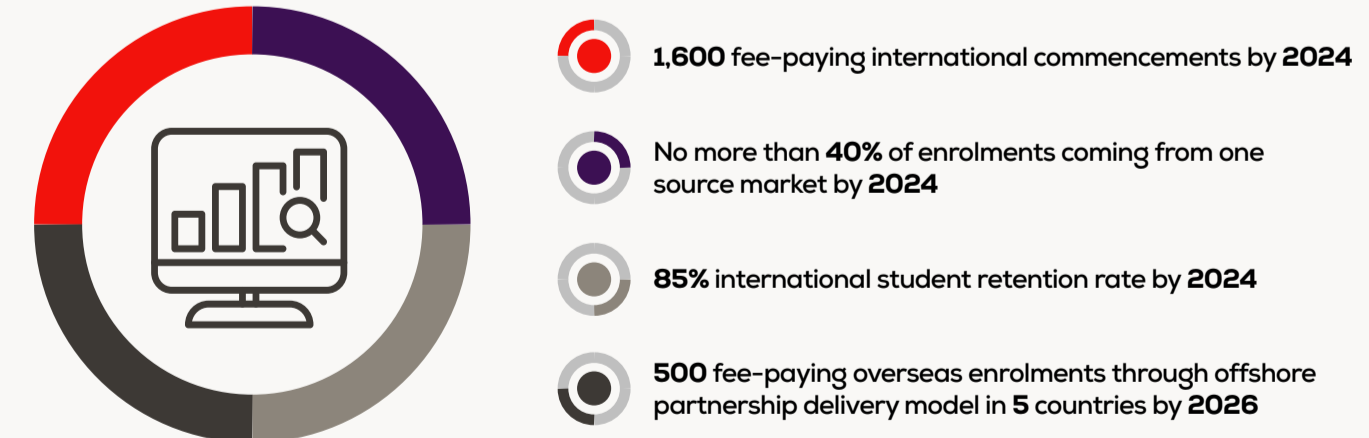
The plan’s 10 strategic initiatives are categorised under three key priority areas:
