Notes:

The <u>Interpolated Median (IM)</u> is the central tendency for the rating-type items in SELT surveys; the five-point rating scale is from Strongly Agree (=5) to Strongly Disagree (=1). The SELT survey results are finalised and reported in half-year cycles (i.e., First Half cycle and Second Half cycle). A report up until the 2024 First Half SELT survey cycle was generated based on the criteria that: a unit (i.e., CRN code in Banner system) has a minimum of 10 enrolled students, and a minimum of five student responses were received for calculating IM values. From the 2024 Second Half SELT survey cycle a report was generated based on a minimum of one student response being received.

The trend analysis compares recent finalised SELT survey results with results for equivalent items in previous survey cycles. The first table displays the number and percentage of units with relatively **high IM values (i.e. IM values > 4.5)** and **low IM values (i.e. IM values < 3.5)** for each Core Item of SELT questionnaire, and the second table displays the total number of reports that were generated and disseminated for each half-year cycle.
