


# Support services for our students

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students	Each ACU campus has its own hub for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students. Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students are encouraged to make contact with the Indigenous Higher Education Unit (IHEU) on their campus. Academic Skills Unit	Academic skills advisers collaborate with academic staff to provide embedded tutorials and discipline-specific workshops within units.  Academic skills advisers are also available for individual, group and drop-in consultations and scheduled online consultations with students.  During semester, generic skills workshops are offered to students on all campuses, including academic reading, writing, referencing, exam preparation, time management and more.  Online resources for the development of students are available on the Academic Skills LEO page. Resources are continually revised, updated and expanded. Campus Ministry	Campus Ministry builds a community for students on our campuses in addition to providing gathering spaces, opportunities and a liturgical rhythm for students to deepen their faith and express it.  We help students engage in social justice and outreach activities and connect them with church communities.  Through Campus Ministry students have access to a team dedicated to their wellbeing, supported by a professional referral network. Career Development Service	Career advisers collaborate with academic staff to provide embedded sessions, tailored discipline-specific content and online resources to address graduate employability. The Career Development Service offers students and graduates direct and online consultations, employer engagement events, workshops and resources.  ACU CareerHub allows students to search for jobs, internships and vacation employment. The 'Ask an Adviser' function provides students with the opportunity to have their applications reviewed online.  ACU Student Jobs on Campus offers employment opportunities so students can 'earn where they learn' on their own campus. Community engagement	Through community engagement students can put classroom learning into action. They have the opportunity to work with local and international communities to develop meaningful solutions to complex problems.	studentportal.acu.edu.au/ community
Counselling	Counsellors provide free, confidential assessment and counselling support to students in person or online.  Twenty minute drop-in sessions are available daily at 12 and 12.30pm on all campuses (except Ballarat and Canberra).  The counsellors offer mental health first aid training, which educates and raises awareness about mental health and empowers people to respond appropriately. Disability advisers, in consultation with students, develop Education Inclusion Plans (EIP) with recommended reasonable adjustments to meet the accessibility needs of students with disabilities or health conditions. Student leadership	ACU offers a leadership program for students known as Leading with Impact. This program has been developed in line with ACU's Mission and graduate attributes. Student Portal	The Student Portal is a student's one-stop shop for academic and co-curricular activities, services and opportunities at ACU. It provides information personalised to each student, including their schedule and student details. It also includes the student website, news feeds and important information notifications.  Staff may view the non-personalised version of the portal using their staff login.	studentportal.acu.edu.au
Student retention	PASS (Peer Assisted Study Sessions) are free, voluntary, small group study sessions that help students succeed in challenging units/subjects. Weekly PASS sessions are facilitated by current ACU students who excelled in the units/subjects in the past. PASS sessions run for one hour and are offered weekly during semester, commencing in Week 2.  The Success at ACU service contacts undergraduate students in their first semester to discuss how they are managing university life. Success at ACU will then make appropriate referrals or recommend various courses of action to support a student's progress. The service follows up with students to encourage check on their progress and to receive feedback on their overall experience. Student transition program	Connect2Uni is a full-year program for transitioning commencing undergraduate students into university. The program replaces ACU Smart from Semester 1, 2019. Selected students are invited to attend the Transition Day which is scheduled before Orientation.
