Academic Skills Unit	 Academic Skills Advisors collaborate with academic staff to provide embedded tutorials and discipline-specific workshops within units around learning skills, academic language and maths. Academic Skills Advisors are also available online for individual, group and drop-in consultations. During semester, the Academic Skills Unit offers generic skills workshops to students online. Topics include maths, academic reading, writing, referencing, exam preparation and time management. A range of interactive online resources designed to help students develop their skills is available on the Academic Skills Unit page on LEO. Ask an Advisor, an online service where students can ask questions and get an email response, is also available. Commencing students can also seek extra support through the 24/7 on-demand study support service, which offers online chat and writing feedback. 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Counselling	 Students can access free, confidential assessment and counselling support online and by phone. Please note that: appointments with a counsellor can only be made online two 20-minute drop-in sessions are available daily at 12pm and 1pm on all campuses (except Ballarat and Canberra) an out-of-hours crisis counselling line is available from 5pm to 9am (AEST) on Monday to Friday, and 24/7 on weekends and public holidays. The counsellors offer mental health first-aid training, which educates and raises awareness about mental health and empowers people to respond appropriately. A number of workshops are offered each semester to help students manage the demands of studying and develop personal resilience.
